For the month of September, we will be helping Santa's Castle on Fort Benning. For years they have been providing toys to children of soldiers who might not otherwise receive anything on Christmas.

Toys can be for boys or girls, infants through teens. Almost anything will do. We do ask that you refrain from picking out toy guns or anything else you would find inappropriate for your own child. Again, there is no need to wrap them as the soldiers get to "shop" for their children at Santa's Castle. Our school will take care of delivering the donations. We will accept toys through the month of September.
